# Exceptions made to the use of European specifications

Article 18(6) of Directive 93/38/EEC

WORKS SUPPLIES SERVICES

Derogation from the obligation to define technical specifications by reference to European specifications was made because:

(for detailed text see the relevant article)

it is technically impossible to establish satisfactorily that the product conforms to the European specifications;

the application of the obligation would prejudice the application of Council Directive 86/361/EEC of 24 July 1986 on the initial stage of the mutual recognition of type approval for telecommunications terminal equipment, or of Council Decision 87/95/EEC of 22 December 1986 on standardisation in the field of information technology and telecommunications;

use of specifications would oblige the contracting entity to acquire supplies incompatible with equipment already in use or would entail disproportionate cost or disproportionate technical difficulty;

the relevant European specification is inappropriate for the particular application or does not take account of technical developments which have come about since its adoption;

the project is of a genuinely innovative nature for which use of European specifications would not be appropriate.
